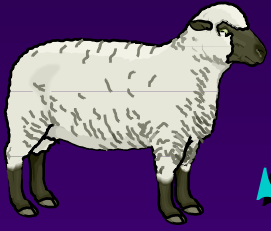
Major Kinds of Sacrifice

Grain offering	Lev. 2
Fellowship offering	Lev. 3
Sin offering	Lev. 4:1-5:13
Guilt offering	Lev. 5:14-6:7

Sin Offering

Term: “sin” offering

Distinctiveness: dealing with sin

Purpose: cleansing from sin

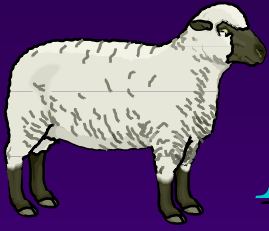
Point: atonement

Christ is

substitute
cleansing sin
(1 John 1:7)

Procedure of Sin Offering

Individual or group has sinned.

The guilty person picks a perfect animal of the appropriate kind.

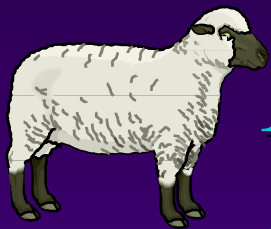
Bring it to God's house to slaughter.

Kill it.

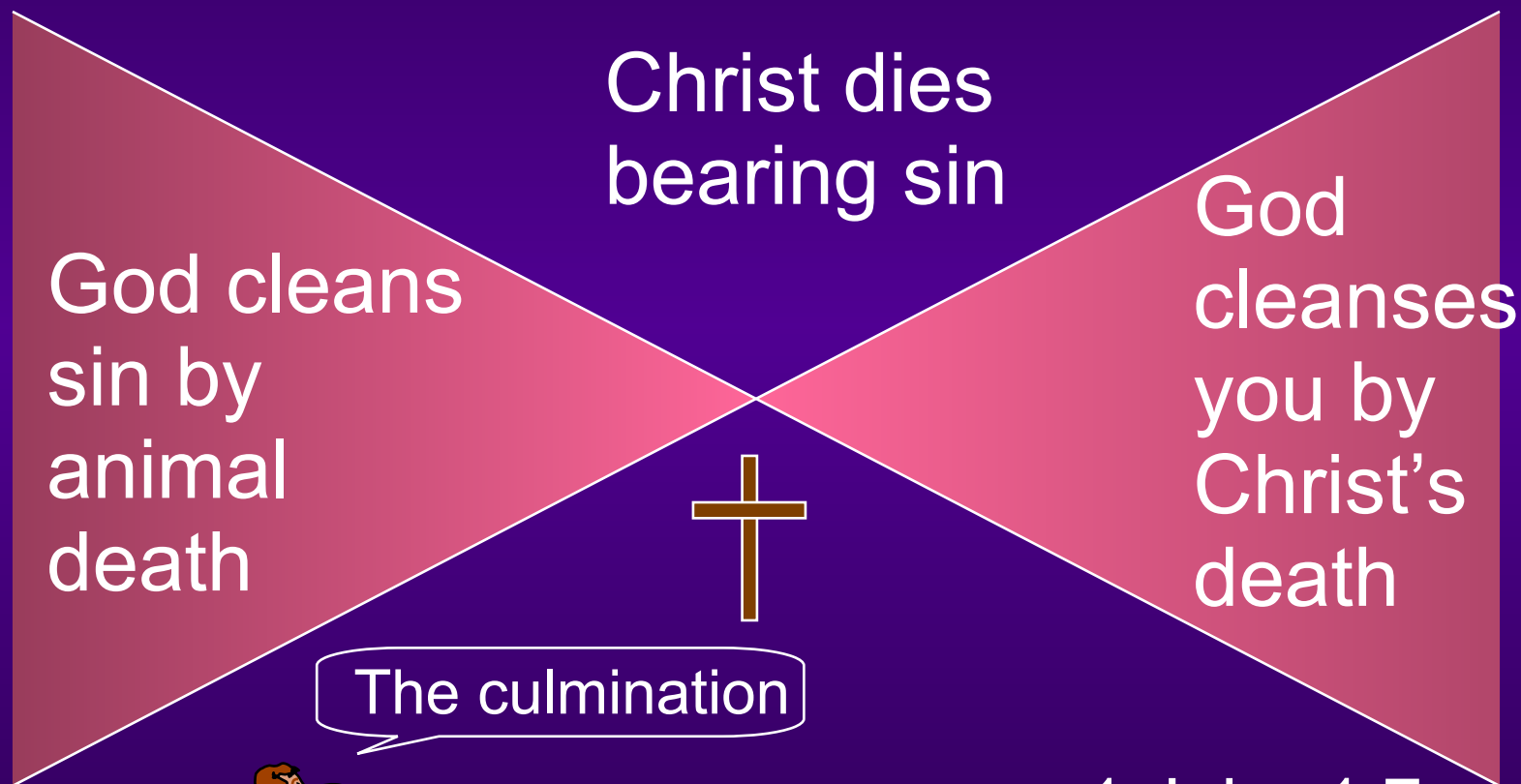
Give it to the priest to offer to God.

Receive cleansing.

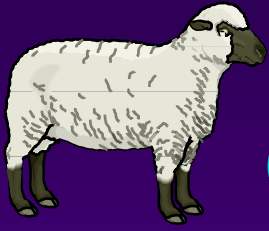

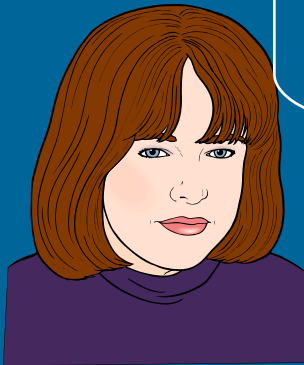


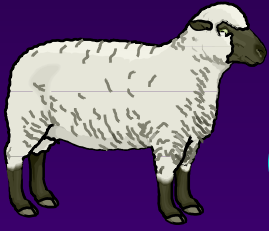
Cleaning Sin

Guilt Offering

Term: “trespass”

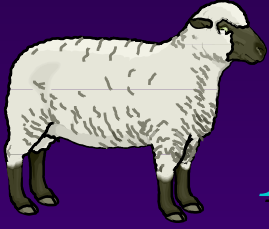
Distinctiveness: deal with trespasses of holiness

When: after violations of holiness

Purpose: cleansing from particular trespasses with respect to holy things

Instead of a sin offering

Point: atonement; satisfying the holiness of God



Fellowship Offering

**Term: “fellowship,
friendship” (“peace”)**

**Distinctiveness:
a meal with God**

**Purpose:
intimacy with God**

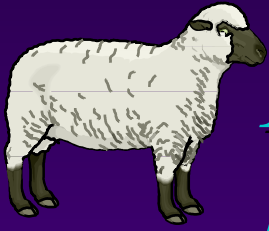
**Point: intimacy is in

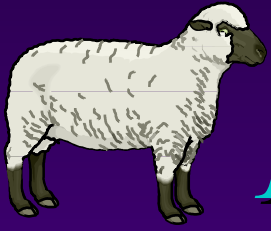

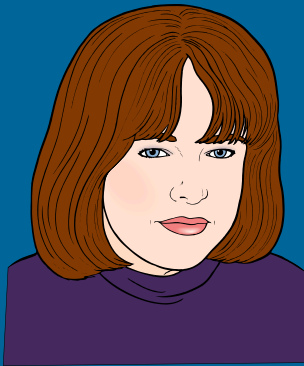


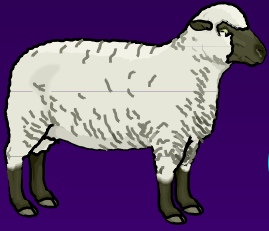

Term: “gift, tribute”

Distinctiveness: grain, not animals

he deserves**

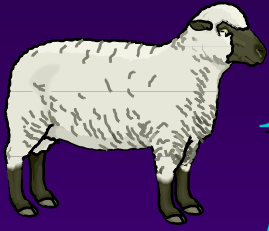
**Point: Christ presents

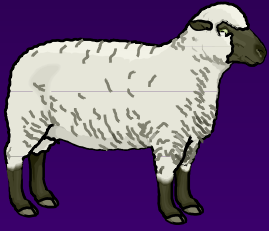

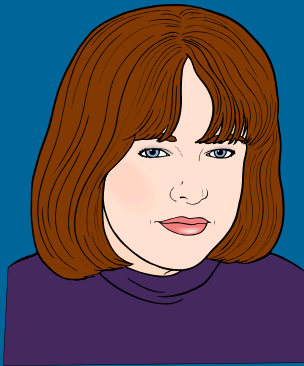


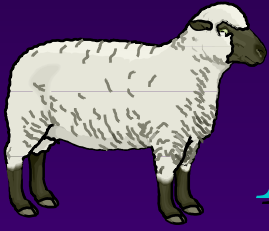

Distinctiveness: completely burned

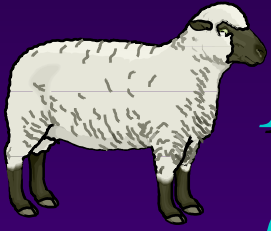
Purpose: dedication to God; destruction
