

# A. Challenges of Gen. 1-3

- ◆ Framework for all of history
- ◆ Framework for redemption
- ◆ Possible conflicts with scientific claims
- ◆ From an unfamiliar cultural setting
- ◆ Sparse
- ◆ Presuppositional influence

- ◆ Bible is the infallible word of God


# Subordinate Presuppositions

# Evidence of Nonfiction

- ◆ Genre like Numbers and 1-2 Samuel
- ◆ Realistic depiction
- ◆ Tie with later history (Exod. to 2 Kings)
- ◆ Later biblical references assume real people
- ◆ Luke 3:23-38
- ◆ 1 Cor. 15:22

# Real Death to Race


For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.

Genesis Is about Real World



# Genesis 1:3

And God said, "Let there be light," and there was light.

He dawns on them like the morning light. —  
2 Sam. 23:4

# Genesis 1:6

And God said, "Let there be an expanse in the midst of the waters, and let it separate the waters from the waters."

And at the seventh time he said, "Behold, a little cloud like a man's hand is rising from the sea." – 1 Kings 18:44

# Genesis 1:9

And God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry land appear."

And it will rise over all its channels and go over all its banks, and it will sweep on into Judah, it will overflow and pass on, reaching even to the neck, .... – Isaiah 8:7-8

# Genesis 1:11

And God said, "Let the earth sprout vegetation, ...."

to satisfy the waste and desolate land, and to make the ground sprout with grass? – Job 38:27
