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A. Definition of Creation




"Creation is the act of God alone by which he brings into existence what had no existence prior to the created world."

(As described in Genesis 1:1-2:1.)

Creation Takes Place in Time


Creation involves specific acts in time.

Creation is not eternal, not always taking place.







Creation is distinct from God, not an emanation that participates in divine being.












Three Persons with Distinct Roles Father as







Polytheism:

Let's make up a myth to express our feelings and guesses.












The Apostles' Creed:

"Our help is in the name of the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth" (Ps. 124:8).






Creation "frames" our understanding of <u>everything</u>.




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Flagellum Cross Section




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Flagellum Cross Section (2)
