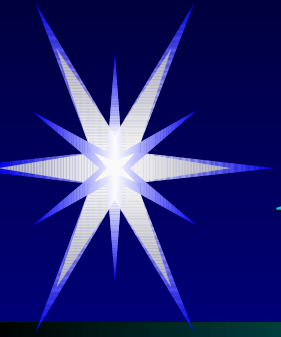
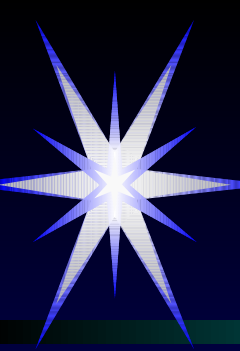

Hebrews 4:2: Continuity with Israel

saying, “I will tell of your name to my brothers; in the midst of the congregation I will sing your praise.”



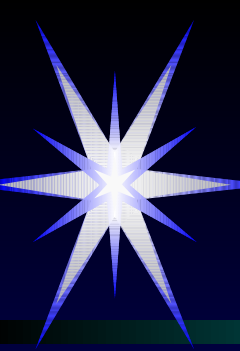

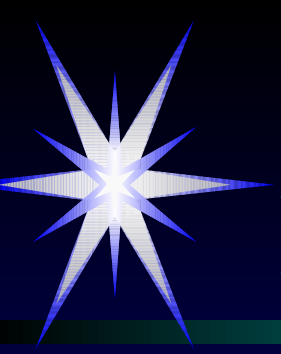
C. Greater Priest

but he holds his priesthood permanently, because he continues forever.



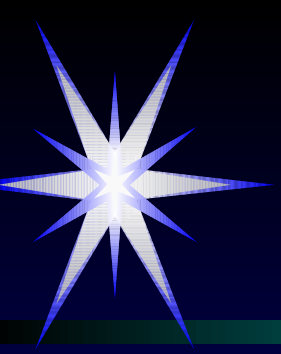

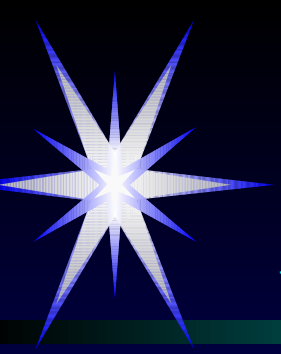




Hebrews 10:19-20: Access Opened

by the new and living way that he opened for us through the curtain, that is, through his flesh,



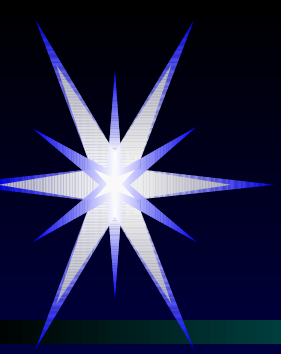

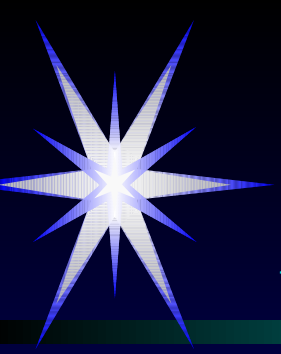

But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering,



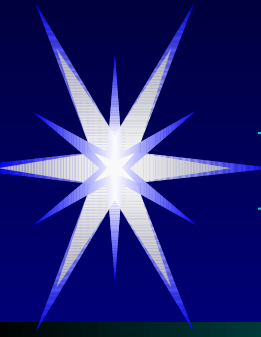

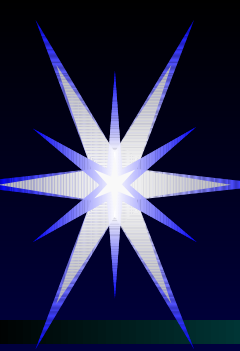

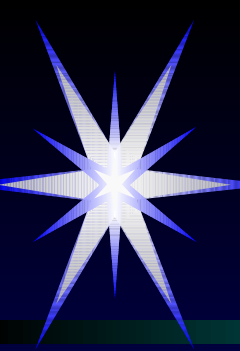


D. Exhortations and Warnings



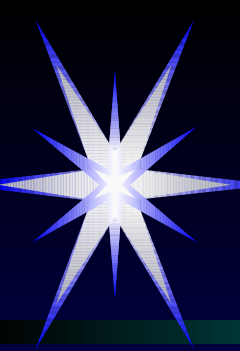
Hebrews 4:14: Persevere

Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God let us hold fast our confession.



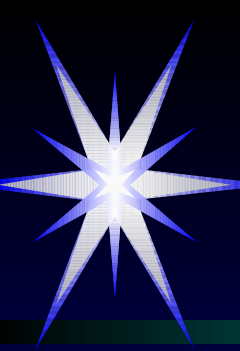
Hebrews 4:1: Warning

Therefore, while the promise of entering his rest still stands, let us fear lest any of you should seem to have failed to reach it.



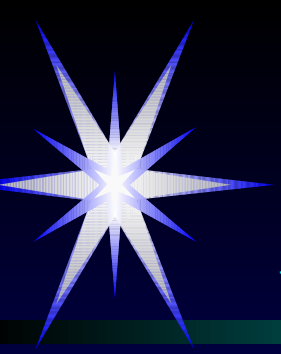
Hebrews 6:4-5: Apostasy

For it is impossible, in the case of those who have once been enlightened, who have tasted the heavenly gift, and have shared in the Holy Spirit, and have tasted the goodness of the word of God and the powers of the age to come,

and then have fallen away, to restore them again to repentance, since they are crucifying once again the Son of God to their own harm and holding him up to contempt.



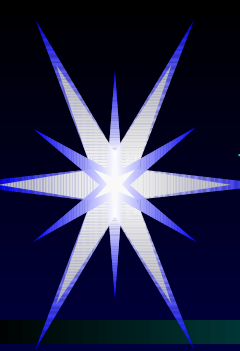

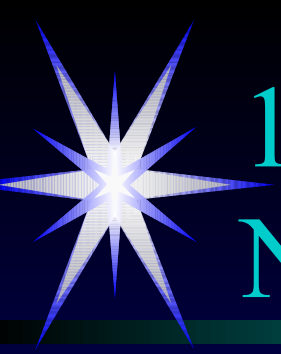

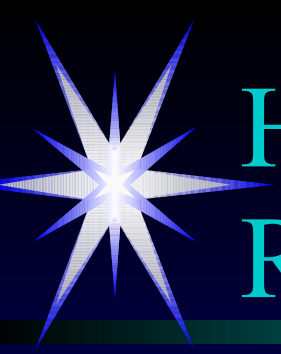
Nature of Apostasy

- ▶ Participating in the covenant community
- ▶ Experiencing through the community the presence of God and his gifts and powers
- ▶ But without a circumcised heart
- ▶ Those who fall were never renewed inwardly

They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would have continued with us. But they went out, that it might become plain that they all are not of us.



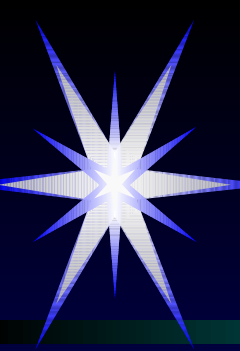
Hebrews 12:1: Reality of Christ

Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us,



Hebrews 12:1-2: Reality of Christ

looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God.
